

THE LECHE TRUST – GENERAL CONDITIONS OF GRANT

1. In these general conditions, 'you' means the organisation to which we propose to make a grant, 'we' means The Leche Trust (registered charity no 225659), 'grant' means any such financial assistance as we may offer to you, and 'project' means the works or activities described in your application to us for financial support.
2. If you wish to accept the grant, you should return a signed copy of these Grant Conditions to us to arrive within two months of the date of the offer letter.
3. You will only use the grant for the project as set out in the offer letter. Any other proposed use must first be notified to us in writing as soon as possible, which we may approve or not in our absolute discretion.
4. Any part of the grant that is not required for the approved purpose is to be refunded to the Trust.
5. Grants for performing arts projects will be paid on formal acceptance of our Grant Conditions.
6. Grants for conservation are normally paid on completion of the project, and must be claimed within two years unless, in the opinion of the Trustees, there are exceptional circumstances which justify the grant period being extended. You will keep us informed of the progress of the project, and if not completed within one year, you will provide a brief update on progress one year from the offer date.
7. Objects or buildings conserved with our grants must be accessible to members of the public. The access must be reasonable subject to the nature, location and condition of the object or building concerned.
8. In the case of works to historic buildings it is the responsibility of applicants to ensure that any necessary licences, approvals or consents have been obtained from those bodies whose consent is required, and in the case of grants to churches, that the necessary Faculty is obtained for work to monuments, furniture or fittings.
9. You undertake not to dispose of any object which has benefited from a grant from us without our prior written consent. We may require repayment of the grant as a condition of that consent, or if any work is subsequently done to a relevant object in contravention of the grant conditions. Should you consider the disposal of the object for which this grant is offered, we should be notified in writing at the earliest opportunity.
10. We reserve the right for our Trustees and staff to inspect work in progress or completed objects in respect of which grant-aided work has been carried out.

11. Any works proposed in the future, which materially affect an object in respect of which a grant has been made, shall be submitted to us before work begins. If this condition is not complied with, we reserve the right to require repayment of the grant.
12. You will acknowledge that the grant has been given by The Leche Trust in any publicity material in connection with the project. Receipt of the grant cheque will be acknowledged in writing, by post or by e-mail.
13. You will, on request, supply us with photographs of the project free of charge or, in the case of performance projects, with a copy of the programme if relevant. You will provide us with a brief report at the conclusion of the project, assessing its impact and benefits.
14. If any of the above conditions are not complied with, we reserve the right to cancel the offer of grant, or to claim repayment of the grant if already paid.
15. You and/or the persons on whose behalf an application is made are aware that the information which the application contains may be shared by us with members of the Association of Charitable Foundations and other relevant bodies and have given consent thereto.
